No later than ten days prior to the first hearing date, each party shall pay to the Arbitrator their share of a retainer fee in accordance with an invoice to be distributed to the parties, reflecting the Arbitrator's best estimate of the likely time necessary to heard and decide these disputes.
- 4. The parties agree that the Arbitrator's decision shall be final and binding, and subject to confirmation in the Mass. Superior Court under M.G.L. c. 251.
